Five-day training in coding caregiver sensitivity with Prof. Dr. Marian Bakermans-Kranenburg

Workshop Rating Caregiver Sensitivity Ainsworth and Erickson

During the training, morning sessions will be devoted to instruction and explanation. Homework assignments will be given for the afternoon, when participants code individually or in pairs cases that will be discussed in the next morning session. It is possible for participants to bring in cases from their own studies.

After the training, participants can obtain a reliability set. Passing this test leads to certification as a reliable coder for caregiver sensitivity with the Ainsworth's scales for sensitivity and cooperation (for infants up to 18 months) or Erickson's scales for supportive presence and intrusiveness (for older children). The training will include both systems, with explicit attention to the overlap and differences. Reliability sets for the two systems will be different. Lisbon is a beautiful city and not too expensive. In January afternoon high temperatures tend to be near 15°C/59°F with a few of the warmer afternoons getting up to near 18°C/64°F
